2023/136 Welcome and introduction from the Chairman of the Parish Council Councillor Moore welcomed everyone to the meeting.

2023/137 To receive any apologies for absence

Apologies were received and accepted from Councillor Goodith White.

2023/138 To receive any disclosures of interest or requests for dispensation

No further disclosures of interest from those made at the Annual Parish Council meeting were given at the meeting and no requests for dispensation had been received by the Clerk.

2023/139 Public consultation and question time

Three members of the public were present.

Councillor Bob Felstead was in attendance. He inquired whether the Parish Council wished him to include any comments in his response to Simon D'Vali about the traffic and highways proposals for Menston. He also advised the meeting that he intends to arrange a meeting at Burley in Wharfedale to discuss aircraft departure routes and noise preferential routes.

It was agreed to nominate Councillor Banister to submit a response on behalf of the Parish Council, with the prerogative as editor to make any amendments agreed at the meeting. A proposal to support the proposal to introduce a one-way system in Leathley Road was defeated by three votes to two. It was agreed that this road would benefit from a sign advising drivers that the road has a weight limit restriction.

Councillor Smith thanked the sub-committee for holding an additional meeting and preparing the response on behalf of the Parish Council.
